He works extensively with Chinese government bodies such as Chinese customs, inspection and quarantine, food regulatory bodies, and banking institutions.

He recently co-founded a Guangzhou company to develop and implement commercialisation pathway for foreign technology firms through offering China market entry and growth strategies, access to industry leaders and strategic institutional investors, and coordination of distribution/licensee contracts, and government funding. Chuan was also Executive Officer of AustCham South China from 2014-2016 where he was tasked with the overall management the chamber operations in its South China branch. His major responsibilities include but is not limited to events organisation, media liaison, member services, marketing and direct liaison and monthly reporting to directors.
